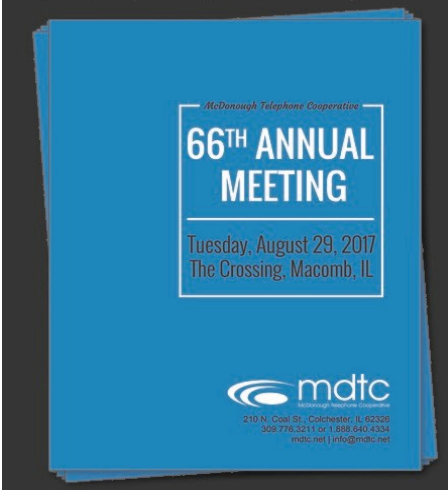

Zucchini Pizza Casserole

- | | |
|---|--|
| 4 c shredded unpeeled zucchini | 1 c shredded cheddar cheese, divided |
| 1/2 t salt | 1 lb ground beef |
| 2 large eggs | 1/2 c chopped onion |
| 1/2 c grated parmesan cheese | 1 can (15 oz) Italian tomato sauce |
| 2 c shredded mozzarella cheese, divided | 1 med green or sweet red pepper, chopped |

Preheat oven to 400. Place zucchini in colander; sprinkle with salt. Let stand 10 minutes, then squeeze out moisture.

Combine zucchini with eggs, parmesan & half of mozzarella & cheddar cheeses. Press into 13x9 pan. Bake 20 minutes

In a large saucepan, cook beef and onion over medium heat, crumbling until meat is no longer pink; drain. Add tomato sauce; spoon over zucchini mixture. Sprinkle with remaining cheeses; add red pepper. Bake until heated through, about 20 minutes longer.

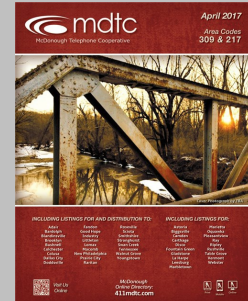
- Italian sausage or ground turkey can be used. Use any of your favorite pizza toppings.
- Make it vegetarian by skipping meat and increasing veggies & adding mushrooms.
- Use your favorite pizza sauce instead of the Italian tomato sauce.
