### 2021 FRS Scholarship Program

The Foundation for Rural Service (FRS) Scholarship Program offers an annual college scholarship to help further higher education among rural youth and encourages these young people to return to rural communities after graduation. FRS awards one-time \$2,500 scholarships to students from rural America for their first year of college, university, or vocational-technical school.

By May 1, 2021, FRS will award the \$2,500 scholarships to rural high school seniors. FRS funds \$2,000 of the scholarship and the remaining \$500 amount of the scholarship comes from the student's local sponsoring company, McDonough Telephone. ### An Important Message About Illinois Relay

The Illinois Telecommunications Access Corporation (ITAC) provides telecommunications relay service in Illinois to people who are Deaf, Hard-of-hearing, Speech-Disabled, or Deaf-Blind and allows them to place and receive calls to standard telephone users via a keyboard or assistive device. Illinois Relay is a free service, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Trained operators type the hearing caller's spoken words to the TTY caller and speak the typed words to the hearing person. Calls are billed at regular telephone company rates. ITAC also distributes TTYs at no charge to qualified Illinois Residents.

Recipe Title: Garlic Butter Roasted Carrots

Ingredients: 2 pounds carrots,

diagonally cut into about 2

to 3-inch pieces

5 tablespoons butter

4 garlic cloves, minced

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon pepper

chopped fresh parsley, for garnish

Directions:

Preheat oven to 425F. Grease a baking sheet with cooking spray; set aside. Cut up the carrots and set aside.

Melt butter in medium-heat nonstick skillet. Add garlic and cook for 3 minutes, or until lightly browned, stirring frequently.

Toss the carrots with the garlic butter either in the pan or pour the butter over them in a mixing bowl. Toss until well combined."

Transfer carrots to previously prepared baking sheet. Arrange in one layer and bake for 22-30 minutes, or until carrots are tender.

Remove from oven and taste for seasoning. Garnish with parsley.
