Recipe Of The Month

1/2 cup unsalted butter

l cup all-purpose flour

l tbsp baking powder

1/4 cup lemon juice

Zest of I lemon

2 cups hot water

1/2 cups granulated sugar,

1 cup milk

Recipe: Magic Lemon Cobbler Delight

Directions: — Preheat your oven to 350°F. In a 9×9-inch baking dish, melt butter by placing it in the oven while it preheats. Once melted, remove it from the oven and set aside. In a mixing bowl, combine flour, I cup of granulated sugar, baking powder, and salt. Stir well. Add milk, lemon juice and zest to the dry ingredients. Mix until smooth. Pour the batter over the melted butter in the baking dish, but do not stir. Sprinkle the remaining ½ cup of granulated sugar evenly over the top of the batter. Carefully pour the hot water over the batter (again, do not stir). Bake for 40-45 min. or until the top is golden brown and the cobbler has set. The "magic" happens as it bakes, forming a gooey lemony layer at the bottom. Allow the cobbler to cool slightly before serving. Serve warm with whipped cream or vanilla ice cream for an extra indulgence.
