

### Recipe Of The Month

Recipe Title: Philly Cheesesteak Sliders

Ingredients:

12 Slider rolls

I box Thinly sliced steak (found in frozen food section) I Green pepper, diced I Onion, diced

6 slices Provolone cheese 2 tosp Mayonnaise

3 thep Butter, melted Salt & Pepper to taste Directions:

Preheat over to 350°F. Separate the tope and bottoms of your rolls and place the bottoms in an II' x 7" casserole dish. Cook the steak meat in a skillet, adding salt and pepper to taste. Place the steak aside, Saute the pepper and onlons until they are tender. Prep the bread by spreading a thin layer of mayo on the tops and bottoms of the rolls. When the meat, crions and peppers have finished cooking spread the steak, then peppers, and onlons evenly over the bottom pieces of bread in the casserole dish. Place a layer of provolone cheese over the peppers and onlone. Place the top pieces of bread on top of the cheese and then brush the tops of the bread with a mix of melted butter and finally diced onlone. Cover with foil and bake for IO minutes, then remove foil and continue baking for another IO minutes for until cheese is melted). Cut and serve.
