Lifeline/Link-up

McDonough Telephone participates in two programs for low-income customers to help offset the cost of telephone and broadband service. Link-Up Assistance provides a one-time credit towards installation of residential phone or broadband service. Lifeline assistance provides a monthly credit on the subscriber's phone/broadband bill. Eligible customers must reside in a household with either a residential phone line or internet service and receive benefits from one of the following programs:

- Medicaid
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans Pension or Survivors Benefits Program
- Household annual income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

There are several options to apply for Lifeline. You may apply directly through the Lifeline programs National Verifier online portal (<a href="https://www.checklifeline.org/lifeline">https://www.checklifeline.org/lifeline</a>). You may also apply for the program by working with a Lifeline service provider either in-person at a store location or online via the service provider's website, if they support that option. ### Affordable Connectivity Program Helping Households Connect

#### The FCC's Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program is a Federal Communications Commission program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service. This new benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward broadband service for eligible households. The ACP is non-transferable and limited to one monthly internet discount per household. Eligible households can enroll through a participating broadband provider or directly with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) using an online or mail in application. ## Recipe Of The Month

Recipe: Honey Butter Skillet Corn



- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 1 bag (16 oz) frozen corn
- 2 oz. cream cheese, cut into
- chunks
- 4 teaspoon salt
- 4 teaspoon black pepper

#### Directions:

In a skillet pan, over medium-high heat, melt the butter and honey. Once melted add the frozen corn and cook for 5-8 minutes, stirring occasionally, until cooked through.

Add cream cheese, salt, and pepper. Stir together and let it cook, about 3-5 minutes, while stirring occasionally.

Serve immediately. Leftovers keep well, covered in a container, and stored in the fridge.
