Of The Month

Recipe: Maple Walnut Twice Baked Sweet Potatoes

Ingredients:

4 small sweet potatoes ½ cup Greek yogurt or sour cream

½ Tbls. pumpkin pie spice 1 Tbls. maple syrup

3-4 Tbls. brown sugar pinch of salt Topping:

% cup chopped walnuts or becans

2 Tbls. butter

2 Tbls. light brown sugar

Directions:

Preheat your oven to 400°F. Pierce the potatoes with a fork, place in a large baking pan and bake until soft (time will vary depending on the size of your potatoes, anywhere from 20-45 min.). Cut each potato in half lengthwise. Scoop out the baked insides. Try to keep the skins whole as much as possible! Place the potato skins back in the baking pan. Mash the baked potato flesh in a bowl until smooth. Mix in the Greek yogurt, pumpkin pie spice, maple syrup, brown sugar & salt. Scoop this filling into the sweet potato skins. In a separate bowl, mix all topping ingredients. Sprinkle over the filled sweet potato skins. Bake at 400°F for 12-15 min. Drizzle with extra syrup to serve if you like, and serve hot.
