CYBER SECURITY: SPAM EMAILS

17.6 million people in the U.S. experience some form of identity theft each year. Here are some tips to protect yourself!


- 1. Do not open or respond to emails that look suspicious
- 2. Do not open an attachment you weren't expecting
- 3. Do not click on a link in an email unless you are 100% sure it is safe to do so
- 4. Don't be fooled by 'phishing' attempts
- 5. Be wary of messages from companies that already have your email address
- 6. Never reply to a spam message.
- 7. Use a spam filter

MTC would NEVER ask for your personal info (SSN, credit cards, income, etc.) through email. If you receive an email with links or forms that ask for your personal info, DO NOT fill out that info. If you're unsure about the email, call the office of the company you've received the email from directly, NOT through the phone number provided in the email.

Recipe Of The Month

Recipe Title: French Toast Casserole

Ingredients:

½ a loaf of French bread, (about 80z.) cut into cubes ½ cup butter

cup packed brown sugar

6 eggs

2 cups milk

2 tsp. vanilla extract

2 tsp. cinnamon, divided I tbsp. brown sugar, for

topping powdered sugar for topping, optional Directions:

Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Butter a 13x9 inch baking pan and set aside.

In a small sauce pan, melt butter over medium heat. Once butter has melted, stir in brown sugar until dissolved and mixture is smooth. Pour mixture into the bottom of a 9x13 pan and spread evenly.

Add bread cubes to the pan, spreading over the top of the brown sugar/butter mixture.

In a medium sized bowl, whisk together the eggs, milk, vanilla, and I tsp of cinnamon. Pour egg mixture over the top of bread cubes, ensuring that all pieces of bread are saturated. Sprinkle with remaining I teaspoon of cinnamon and I tablespoon of brown sugar.

Bake in preheated oven for 25-30 minutes until top is golden brown. Remove from oven and sprinkle with powdered sugar if desired. Enjoy!
